Dear Resident,

M6 junctions 13 to 15 smart motorway: overnight working near junction 14

As you will be aware, we are upgrading the M6 between junctions 13 and 15 to a smart motorway by converting the hard shoulder to a permanent running lane. We're doing this to add further capacity along this busy stretch of motorway.

What are we doing and when?

We'll be resurfacing sections of the southbound carriageway from junction 14 to Creswell Viaduct. This work will take place overnight on or shortly after **Monday 5 October** and will take approximately 8 nights to complete between the hours of 10pm and 5am. We'll return to the area to complete the resurfacing on **Friday 16 October to Sunday 18 October**. To facilitate this work, junction 14 southbound exit slip road will be closed.

While we hope to complete the work as promptly as possible, it is weather dependent and may be postponed due to wet or windy conditions. We understand that working at night may cause disturbance to residents and we would like to apologise for any inconvenience you may experience.

Why can't we do this work during the day?

For safety reasons, we'll need to carry out this work overnight under single lane closures to ensure that loose chippings don't enter a live lane of traffic. It's safer to do this at night when there are fewer cars on the road.

What are we doing to reduce disruption?

We'll be breaking out concrete and using a planing machine that will create some noise. We'll make sure that increased lighting for the work area is directed away from residential properties and machinery is turned off when not in use.
